



You will need:

- 1 piece blue card
- Dark blue or grey tissue paper
- 1 regular size cupcake liner
- 2 mini cupcake liners
- 2 eye stickers
- 4 small white, grey or black pipe cleaners
- 1 black pen
- 1 glue stick
- 1 pair of scissors

Instructions

Glue the tissue paper to your piece of card to make rocks or the sea

Glue your larger cupcake liner to the top of your tissue paper

Glue one smaller cupcake liner at the top of your large cupcake liner to give your seal a head

Cut your remaining cupcake liner in half and glue the two halves at the bottom of the large liner for your seal's flippers

Add 2 eye stickers and using the black marker give your seal a nose and mouth

Stick the pipe cleaners onto your seal's cheeks for whiskers

Congratulations! You have made your own seal!
